


CAS-340 control unit top view

Microphone

To turn on the microphone

Press any button for one second.

Microphone input

3.5 mm jack for optional external microphone input



To turn off the microphone

Press the mute button for four seconds.



Auxiliary input

3.5 mm jack for MP3 player or other audio source

Soft button-

Press to mute auxiliary audio input at the control unit.

Volume up ~

Press to increase the microphone volume.

Mute-

Press to mute the microphone.

Volume down -

Press to decrease the microphone volume.

To adjust auxiliary input volume


Press the mute button and then press the volume buttons to adjust volume for auxiliary audio inputs connected to the control unit.

Status light

- Green On and connected to the room module
- Flashing green Muted
- Amber Not connected to the room module
- Flashing red Low battery or charging

To charge the microphone Place the microphone facing

forward in the microphone charging cradle after each use.
