New features

You can use the Alignment Tools add-on to align and distribute objects on a page. You can align selected objects to the bottom, left, right, top, vertically or horizontally. You can also align stacked objects vertically or horizontally.

Resolved issues

General

- When you convert ink handwriting to typed text near the right side of a .notebook page, the converted text is positioned to fit on the page correctly.
- When you draw ink near the bottom edge of a rotated Geodreieck protractor, a straight line that isn't offset from the tool is drawn.

Windows operating systems

- When you export a .notebook file that uses the Calibri® font type to PDF, text characters are intact in the resulting file.
- When you use Full Screen or Transparent Background view, you can move the toolbar away from the top of the screen.

Known issues

General

- You're unable to type characters with an accent when you use a third-party keyboard layout.
- You're unable to rotate a line object after you select it and then click
 Format > Lock > Allow Move and Rotate.

Windows operating systems

- When you use the SMART Document Writer to print a Word file with A4 paper size and custom margins, the content is cut off at the bottom of the resulting .notebook page.
- If you double-click a file that has two consecutive dashes separated by a space in its name, the file doesn't open. You must open SMART Notebook software first and then select
 File > Open.
- You're unable to disconnect an equation and a graph by clicking S. This issue occurs if another object overlaps the S. You must right-click the equation and then select Maths Actions > Disconnect.

Mac operating system software

- If you apply the same solid fill colour to an object and to the background of a page, the colour
 of the object appears darker than the colour of the page. This occurs when hardware
 acceleration is enabled.
- You're unable to type characters with a circumflex, an umlaut or a diaeresis after you change your keyboard input source to Canadian French.
