- Resolved SMART GoWire auto-launch cable issues:
 - SMART Meeting Pro software 2.3 resolves an issue that caused SMART Meeting Pro software to stop responding if no SMART interactive product is connected to your computer and an unrelated error message appears.
 - SMART Meeting Pro software 2.3 removes an error message that appeared when you removed the SMART GoWire auto-launch cable.
 - The Aware toolbar appears in Aware-enabled applications.

Known issues

- Some text in the Organizer view hasn't been translated into languages other than English.
- Known SMART GoWire auto-launch cable issues:
 - SMART Product Drivers 10.8 on the SMART GoWire auto-launch cable disables
 Windows 7 multitouch features. Multitouch features work in SMART Meeting Pro
 software and are available in other applications that support Windows 7 multitouch when
 the SMART GoWire auto-launch cable isn't connected.
