About these release notes

These release notes summarize the features of SMART Table® 3.1 software and SMART Table Toolkit 2.6.

Product information

The SMART Table collaborative learning center has a touch-sensitive surface. By touching the surface, students can create, select, move and resize digital objects. More than one student can touch the surface at a time. Using the Wi-Fi® network connection to a teacher computer with SMART Sync™ classroom management software, teachers can observe student activity from a distance, take control of the table and capture and print the tabletop image. SMART Table software includes interactive applications, learning activities and educational games.

You can customize activities using SMART Table Toolkit. Install and run the toolkit on your computer, and then transfer your changes to the SMART Table collaborative learning center using a USB drive or SMART Sync classroom management software. You can use the table with other SMART products, including the SMART Document Camera™ and SMART Notebook™ collaborative learning software.

SMART Table 3.1 software summary

About this release

This release introduces new features to SMART Table software.

Scrapbook is an application that allows students to create scrapbooks with text, ink and images. Add images to the scrapbook by using the SMART Document Camera to capture images, by downloading images from the SMART Exchange™ website or by loading images from a USB drive.

Symphony is an application that enables up to four students to play musical instruments on the table and record a musical composition. Students can choose an instrument to play while reading music notation. Save musical compositions to the table or to a USB drive and play them later or on other devices.

- When SMART Notebook is rotated, touch now works correctly.

Known issues

SMART Table software issues

- If you're renaming an activity pack and include an underscore in the new file name (for example, sample_1), the underscore isn't visible until you finish renaming the activity pack.
- If you open an application in the USB tab multiple times, each time you open that application in
 the USB tab an activity pack appears in the Table Content tab. The multiple activity packs in the
 Table Content tab contain only one application. If you delete the multiple activity packs, the
 application remains installed on the table.
- Sometimes an activity pack's title in the Now Open field includes the activity pack file extension, .tableContent.
