**Resolved issues**

**System software**

- Buttons on the IR remote control and at the front of the display were disabled when the Lock screen was shown.
- Speakers muted when the Lock screen or Freeze was shown.
- Couldn't view installed Root CA certificates within security settings.
- Couldn't connect to the network using Ethernet, and the IP address was stuck at 0.0.0.0 after waking up from sleep.
- Couldn't install the Lithuanian handwriting recognition language pack.

- Couldn't save the whiteboard or export it to PDF on a USB drive.
- Couldn't export a whiteboard to PDF if it had the same name as an existing file.

**Embedded apps** SMART Remote Management

- The RemoteExec command *settings* with the arguments *put <options>* do not work. As a workaround, use the command *smartcli* with the arguments *settings put <options>*.
- Apps deployed while a user is signed in won't appear right away. The apps will appear the next time the user signs in.
- Settings selections made while a user is signed in are not applied.
- Trusted credential certificates cannot be deployed using SMART Remote Management and must be installed from the display.

**Browser**

- By default, the Browser presents mobile versions of websites for compatibility and usability with touch. If a site doesn't appear correctly, switching to the Desktop site from within the Browser's menu will usually address any issues.
- Users cannot interact with permission prompts that grant websites access to connected peripherals when a floating window is on the screen, such as the SMART Mirror session ID dialog. Close these floating windows to interact with these permission prompts.

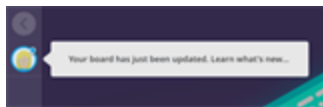

- You can insert images from the display or a connected webcam. See [Inserting images or videos in a whiteboard or lesson file](#).
- Convert writing to text. You can also edit the text using gestures. See [Converting ink to text in a lesson or whiteboard](#)
- You can write or draw with your fingers. Enable writing with your fingers in **Settings > Application settings > SMART Whiteboard > Enable Finger Inking**. See [Using fingers to write or draw in a lesson or whiteboard](#).
- Change the whiteboard aspect ratio to 4:3, 16:9, or an extended 16:9.
- You can write or draw with the display's pens in a Workspace or Handouts activity in a Lumio file.

### SMART Remote Management

- The Clean up feature removes whiteboard files saved locally on the display to reset the display to a clean state.
  - Widgets on the Home screen are in a selection frame to make them easier to move and select.
  - Screenshots are now saved as a SMART Whiteboard file and can be exported to a USB drive.
  - The display can connect to hidden Wi-Fi networks when using SMART Remote Management to configure settings.
  - Users can access their online Lumio files even when saving SMART Whiteboards is disabled.
  - Firmware versions for subcomponents are listed in **Settings > About**.
  - Users can configure the HDMI input DDC SDA timing options to improve compatibility with certain HDMI devices.
  - HDMI 3 input is no longer configured as an HDMI 2.0 input only.
