- AirServer fails to start after reinstalling SMART TeamWorks on a computer after it was reimaged.
- Updating SMART TeamWorks by uninstalling the existing version from the computer, then
 installing the latest version causes AirServer to fail to start. To avoid this, when updating
 SMART TeamWorks, install the latest version over the existing one.

Miracast touchback support for screen sharing. Use your Miracast to share your Windows 10
device's screen to the interactive display with SMART TeamWorks. Then from the display, you
can select shared Windows 10 screen to make it full screen, then use the display to control
the shared devices screen.

NOTES

- o Miracast touchback is only support with Windows 10 version 1809.
- o Only touch is currently supported, SMART Ink is not supported by Miracast touchback.
- If SMART TeamWorks is installed on a computer connected to multiple displays, you now have the option in the settings window to enable recording of the main and extended displays when people use SMART TeamWorks' recording feature.

- In the whiteboard, erasing digital ink now behaves more as expected.
- Resolved issue where new files added to whiteboard caused errors or were not shared with other connected devices after 30 minutes into a whiteboard session.
- Correct web conference buttons are now displayed when the SMART TeamWorks calendar is configured for use with an on-premise Exchange Server
- A vertical scroll bar has been added in the whiteboard's File Manager. This means that if you can now view all of the available locations that are available.
 - Previously if you had more than 7 file locations available, you could not access all of them from the file manager.
- The whiteboard's File Manager now supports long file names. Additionally, when mapping
 network locations to the File Manager, there is no longer a character restriction for the
 Network user field.
- If using GoToMeeting™ as a web conferencing application with SMART TeamWorks, the icon now appears correctly in the SMART TeamWorks calendar. Additionally, the supported URL format for GoToMeeting is now the standard gotomeeting.com, previously it was gotomeeting.me.

- Resolved the issue which prevented screen sharing from working or only partially working
 (audio was shared but not the devices screen). Now when you use screen sharing to mirror
 your device's screen to SMART TeamWorks, it behaves as expected. This issue has been
 resolved with both the full and trial versions of SMART TeamWorks.
- Previously, if you upgraded from SMART TeamWorks 3.0 to 3.1, you had to re-enter your settings. Now when you upgrade from version 3.0 to 3.1.1, SMART TeamWorks' settings are maintained.
- If you are in a SMART TeamWorks whiteboard session and a scheduled meeting is about to start, SMART TeamWorks now notifies you in the whiteboard, giving you time to save your work / create a recap before the next meeting starts. Previously this notification only appeared if you were in the SMART TeamWorks launcher (main screen).
